Using CrateOnScene to Build Sponsorship Opportunities

CrateOnScene is a structured platform used by drivers, event producers, and businesses to manage event participation and sponsorship visibility in one system.

1. What driver sponsorships represent on CrateOnScene

Driver sponsorships on CrateOnScene are a professional way for businesses to **support drivers in exchange for visibility**.

Some sponsorships—such as those offered by Import Crate—are **non-monetary**, but they serve the same structural purpose: they establish visible sponsorship activity and signal that a driver profile has been reviewed within the CrateOnScene system.

2. Why event registration matters

CrateOnScene is built around **verified event participation**.

Every time you register your car for an event on CrateOnScene:

- The event is recorded on your driver profile
- Your participation becomes visible to businesses
- Your profile reflects documented activity

Businesses reviewing drivers rely on event participation to understand:

- ongoing involvement in the scene

Your event history functions as a **participation record** that businesses can reference when evaluating sponsorship opportunities.
